Akaki Beseka – Ethiopia (school and children's village)

- In the outskirts of the capital Addis Ababa
- 62 orphans in families and dormitory
- 31 orphans on colleges and universities
- From kindergarten to high school
- 1018 external students (189 of them boarders)
- 161 workers
- Dairy, apiculture, forestry
- Products: potato, cabbage, beetroot, chard, teff
- Workshop for wood, metal, electricity, and water supply
- Guest house

Kinyo – Uganda (children's village with kindergarten)

- At Lake Victoria
- 62 orphans in two housing units
- 25 external orphans on academies
- Kindergarten and elementary school
- 170 students from the community
- 23 workers
- Water supply from 2 wells and solar power
- Fruit orchards, vegetable and cereal crops
- Chicken farm and forestry
- Guest house



Kigarama – Rwanda (technical school)

- At Lake Kivu
- Senior high school with focus on agriculture (72 students)
- Tailor training (27 apprentices)
- 25 workers
- Fruit orchards and vegetable garden
- Dairy and poultry
- Apiculture and forestry



**Itapecerica – Brazil
(school of health and agriculture)**

- Apostle Paul School for Self-supporting Missionaries in Minas Gerais
- 20 students, 4 workers, 3 volunteers
- Organic-syntropic gardening and natural remedies
- Orchards, vegetable and cereal crops
- water supply from deep well
- Dairy, poultry, and apiculture



**San Mateo – Bolivia
(children's village with carpentry)**

- In the rainforest at the foot of the Andes
- 60 orphans in 6 family units
- 9 workers, 2 ADRA volunteers
- Carpentry, bakery, and apiculture
- Orchards, vegetable and cereal crops
